SET YOUR MINDS ON THING ABOVE

Dear readers let us focus on our divine calling and submit us to God's mighty hands. Let us focus and re-direct ourselves by following simple practical steps in inching closer to God.

1. Begin the day with God

Jesus said in John 15:4, "Abide in me." He repeated that in 2 other ways in John 15:5-7 while also providing a stark warning and a vast promise:

"Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned. If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you."

Staying focused on God requires abiding in Him. I know your mornings are rushed, but if you create the discipline to spend the first minutes of your day reading the Word of God and talking to Him about the day ahead, you will have a greater focus on Him throughout the day.

If you don't know where to start, try reading John 15:1-11.

2. Remain in prayer

Do you want to create and develop the habit of a prayerful life? 1 Thessalonians 5:17 makes one simple yet bold command: **"pray without ceasing."**

When you see or hear a news report that bothers you, pray for the people and the situation. When you come across someone that annoys you or tries your patience, silently pray for them. When you hear of someone facing some problem, large or small...pray for them.

3. Limit the distractions

In Joshua 3:4, the people of Israel are commanded to keep a distance of 2,000 cubits between them and the ark of the covenant. That's about a half of a mile and the purpose was so the people of Israel would always be able to see the ark in all types of terrain that they were travelling through.

In our spiritual lives, when we fill the spaces with all kinds of conveniences and distractions, it becomes very difficult and even impossible sometimes to see where the Lord is leading us.

We can overcome this by limiting the distractions, the busyness and our own lack of discipline by making a



conscious effort to keep our Lord in the number one spot in our lives.

4. Serve God

In Matthew 6:24, Jesus teaches, "No one can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money."

You've heard that verse. You've probably also heard the term mammon in place of money at the end of it. Though "mammon" was a word that primarily represented money and possessions, it was also used to refer to lusts of all types.

If you're serving God with your resources of time, energy, talents, and with your money, then staying focused on God will naturally follow.

5. Remove sin from your life

We have to remove the habitual, continuous sinful habits and patterns from our life.

Hebrews 12:1 says, "Since we are surrounded by so many examples of faith, we must get rid of everything that slows us down, **especially sin that distracts us.**"

If there is something, someone, some place or anything in our life that leads us away from God in any way, or that keeps us out of prayer, away from fellowship with other believers or distracts us from reading Holy Bible, we have one option: **remove that thing from our life.**

Staying focused on God or growing in your spiritual, prayer, or Christian life in any way with any habitual sin in your life is next to impossible. **Kill the sin or it will kill you spiritually, physically, or both.**

Let Our Lives be a sweet offering and incense to Lord Jesus Christ.

On the occasion of the feast of our Patron Saint, St. Thomas, I would like to wish all of my parishioners a blessed feast. May the intercession of St. Thomas be a fortress and refuge for us.

St. Thomas the Apostle

Feast Day: July 3 and December 21

The Apostle Thomas was born in the Galileian city of Pansada and was a fisherman. Hearing the good tidings of Jesus Christ, he left all and followed after him.

According to Holy Scripture, the holy Apostle Thomas did not believe the reports of the other disciples about the Resurrection of Jesus Christ: "Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into His side, I will not believe" (St. John 20:25).

On the eighth day after the Resurrection, the Lord appeared to the Apostle Thomas and showed him His wounds. "My Lord and my God," the Apostle cried out (St. John 20:28). "Thomas, being once weaker in faith than the other apostles," says

St. John Chrysostom, "toiled through the grace of God more bravely, more zealously and tirelessly than them all, so that he went preaching over nearly all the earth, not fearing to proclaim the Word of God to savage nations."

According to Church Tradition, the holy Apostle Thomas founded Christian churches in Palestine, Mesopotamia, Parthia, Ethiopia and India. Church Tradition also indicates that Apostle Thomas baptized the Magicians needed. Preaching the Gospel earned him a martyr's death. For having converted the wife and son of the prefect of the Indian city of Meliapur (Mylapore), the holy apostle was locked up in prison, suffered torture, and finally, pierced with five spears, he departed to the Lord. Part of the relics of the holy Apostle Thomas are in India, in Hungary and on Mt. Athos.

72 Evangelists

Feast Day: July 5

The Seventy Two Evangelists are those whom the Lord chose in addition to the Twelve Apostles and sent forth to assist in the work of preaching. Over time, the Twelve added others to their number, who were sent out with the original Seventy Two to preach the gospel. In Luke 10:1 we read "After his the Lord chose another seventy two men (including Mark and Luke) and sent them out 2 by 2, to go ahead of him to every town and place where he himself was about to go".



St. Yulithi & St. Kuriakose

Feast Day: July 15

The blessed Yulithi (Julietta) and her saintly son trampled the devil and all his wicked means under their feet and received the crowns of martyrdom. Yulithi, a beautiful rich woman and a good Christian, a descendent of the Asian kings, was born in Iconium in Asia Minor where St. Paul and Barnabas founded the church. Yulithi spent most of her time in praying and helping the poor. Yulithi's only son Kuriakose (Cyrucus) grew up in a spiritual atmosphere whose first spoken words were "I am a Christian". When Yulithi's husband passed away all on a sudden, she had to raise her son by herself. Diocletian, the Roman emperor, started the worst Christian persecution when Kuriakose was only three years old.



Yuliti, in order to escape from persecution, fled to Selucia in Syria with two of her maids. As the situation there was also worse, they went to Tarsus, the birthplace of St. Paul. The Roman tetrarch in that city, Alexandros was also very cruel towards Christians. Yuliti was arrested and brought before Alexandros. Because Yuliti confessed that she is a Christian as against all warnings of Alexandros, the soldiers threw Yuliti on the ground after taking away young Kuriakose from her. Alexandros promised to release her if she forsook Jesus Christ to which she answered that even a child, like her son, would not budge. Alexandros asked Kuriakose: "Would you agree to worship the idols". Young Kuriakose replied: "Your idols are made by stone and wood; My real God is Jesus Christ". When Yuliti heard this, she filled with courage shouted: "I am a Christian; I worship the real God Jesus Christ who made heaven and earth". Then Kuriakose also started shouting "I am a Christian; I am a Christian".

Soldiers continued beating Yuliti and the ruler tried to play with the boy to attract his attention. The tetrarch got mad at the child as he was not falling into his trap and threw him to the ground. The young boy hit his head against one of the concrete steps and died instantly. When Yuliti saw this, she prayed: "Thank you my Lord because you considered Kuriakose worthy of receiving this glorious crown. I ask you now my Savior to take me also....." On hearing this, the angered Roman emperor ordered her to be beheaded. Thus she was beheaded while she was repeatedly saying: "I am a Christian, I am a Christian". At night, her two maids took the bodies and hid them in a cave near Tarsus.

When Constantine, the first Roman emperor, came to power, he built a church where the Mother and the child were martyred. Parts of the relics of these two saints' are preserved in the Syrian St. Mary's Monastery in the valley of Nitron. There is also a historical church bearing their name in Tahta.



Prophet Elijah

Feast Day: July 20

Elijah of great fame was from Thisbe or Thesbe, a town of Galaad (Gilead), beyond the Jordan. He was of priestly lineage, a man of a solitary and ascetical character, clothed in a mantle of sheep skin, and girded about his loins with a leathern belt. His name is interpreted as "Yah is my God." His zeal for the glory of God was compared to fire, and his speech for teaching and rebuke was likened unto a burning lamp. From this too he received the name Zealot. Therefore, set aflame with such zeal, he sternly reprov'd the impiety and lawlessness of Ahab and his wife Jezebel. He shut up heaven by means of prayer, and it did not rain for three years and six months. Ravens brought him food for his need when, at God's command, he was hiding by the torrent of Horraath. He multiplied the little flour and oil of the poor widow of Sarephtha. Elijah of great fame was from Thisbe or Thesbe, a town of

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fifty that were sent by the king, he burned them for their punishment, bringing fire down from Heaven. He divided the flow of the Jordan, and he and his disciple Elisseus passed through as it were on dry land; and finally, while speaking with him, Elijah was suddenly snatched away by a fiery chariot in the year 895 B.C., and he ascended as though into heaven, whither God most certainly translated him alive, as He did Enoch (Gen. 5:24; IV Kings 2: 11). But from thence also, after seven years, by means of an epistle he reproached Joram, the son of Josaphat, as it is written: "And there came a message in writing to him from Elijah the Prophet, saying, Thus saith the Lord God of David thy father, Because thou hast not walked in the way," and so forth (II Chron. 21:12). According to the opinion of the majority of the interpreters, this came to pass either through his disciple Elisseus, or through another Prophet when Elijah appeared to them, even as he appeared on Mount Tabor to the disciples of Christ.



St. Mary Magdalene

Feast Day: July 22

Saint Mary was from Magdala in Galilee on the Sea of Tiberias, and for this was named Magdalene. When the Lord Jesus cast out seven demons from her, from which she had been suffering, she became His faithful and inseparable disciple, following Him and ministering unto Him even to the time of His crucifixion and burial. Then, returning to Jerusalem together with the rest of the Myrrh-bearers, she prepared the fragrant spices for anointing the body of the Lord. And on the Lord's day they came very early to the tomb, even before the Angels appeared declaring the Resurrection of the Lord. When Mary Magdalene saw the stone taken away from the tomb, she ran and proclaimed it to Peter and John. And returning immediately to the tomb and weeping outside, she was deemed

worthy to be the first of the Myrrh-bearers to behold the Lord arisen from the dead, and when she fell at His feet, she heard Him say, "Touch Me not." After the Lord's Ascension, nothing certain is known concerning her. Some accounts say that she went to Rome and later returned to Jerusalem, and from there proceeded to Ephesus, where she ended her life, preaching Christ. Although it is sometimes said that Saint Mary Magdalene was the "sinful woman" of the Gospel, this is nowhere stated in the tradition of the Church, in the sacred hymnology, or in the Holy Gospels themselves, which say only that our Lord cast seven demons out of her, not that she was a fallen woman. "Madeleine" is a form of Magdalene.

His Grace Joseph Mar Dionysious Pulikkottil II



Pulikkottil Joseph Mar Dionysious II (Mar Dionysious V), the Malankara Metropolitan, was born into the family of Pulikkottil (Kunnamkulam), a famous and important family in the annals of the history of Malankara church. H. G was a courageous, popular, spiritual leader, who guided his followers through one of the most difficult times in the history of Malankara Church. H. G dedicated his life to the church. Gifted by his grace integrity, and loyalty to the church H. G was even prepared to lay down his life for the church and its beliefs. At a time when modern mode of transportation could not even be dreamed of, H. G crossed the seas, passed through dangerous and unfamiliar terrain, with toil and travail, H. G went up to Turkey to be ordained as a bishop by the Patriarch of Antioch.

Ordination

H. G received the deaconship from Cheppad Mar Dionysious on 6 October 1846 and on 18 August 1853 H. G was ordained as a priest by Metropolitan Yuyakim Mar Kurilos at Challiserry church.

On 29 April 1865 at Ameer (modern day Diyarbak), Patriarch Yakoob II elevated H. G to the rank of Ramban. On 30 April H. G was consecrated as Metropolitan Joseph Mar Dionysios.

Malankara Metropolitan

During the eventful forty-four years between 1892 A.D to 1909 H. G adorned the Malankara Metropolitan's position with extraordinary skill. It was during his grace period that the Mulanthuruthy Synod, division of dioceses and the 'Holy Mooran Koodasha' took place. Through his grace unstinting effort, spiritual organisations like Sunday School and Students movement, and Church institutions like Parumala Seminary, Kunnamkulam Sehiyon Bungalow, Kottapuram Seminary and Kottayam M.D. Seminary developed.

Last days

After entrusting the responsibilities of his grace office to his grace successor Mar Dionysious VI, Pulikkottil Joseph Mar Dionysious II entered into heavenly abode on 11 July 1909. His grace mortal remains were interred in the northern side of the chapel in the Old Seminary (Pazhaya Seminary, known as the Orthodox Theological Seminary). The Church observes the day of his grace memorial on 12 July. The Episcopal Synod honoured his grace memory by conferring the designation "*Malankara Sabha-Thejas*", meaning 'radiance of the Church'.
