

GLORY BE TO THE TRIUNE GOD

Dear Beloved in CHRIST,

We all have physical birthdays, that mark our journey on earth, which we tell others, we have completed so and so years. We should glorify God for giving us every minute in life. Similarly, every Great Lent and Easter, we mark the advancement of our spiritual growth. We should become closer to God and towards doing His Will. The Great Lent and Easter show us how we can overcome our challenges through fasting and prayer and that at the end of our battles, we will be victorious in God's Name.

The Feast of the Ascension of our Lord – 18th May The Ascension of our Lord is celebrated as one of the Twelve Great Feasts of the Church, Our Lord made His last appearance on the earth, along with His beloved Disciples for a period of 40 days, after His Resurrection. During this period, He worked miracles and also taught them about the Kingdom of God. He gave them the Great Commission. instructing them to spread the Gospel to the whole world, baptizing in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. After His final works on earth. He was taken up into Heaven. The book of the Acts of the Apostles 1:3-11, the Gospel according to St. Mark 16:19 and St. Luke 24:50-53 all mention about His Ascension. Ascension is mentioned as "He was lifted up before their eyes in a cloud which took Him from their sight" (Acts 1:9). When the Disciples looked in amazement, two Angels appeared to them and asked them why they were gazing into heaven. Then one of the Angels said, "This same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as you have seen Him going into Heaven" (Acts 1:11).

The Feast of the Holy Pentecost - 28th May The Holy Pentecost is known as the birthday of the Christian Church, All Christian denominations. Orthodox, Protestant and Roman Catholic observe this magnificent feast day of Pentecost. 'Pentecost' is a Greek word meaning 'fiftieth'. Our Lord prior to His Ascension, promised His faithful Disciples and followers about the coming of the power of the Holy Spirit, to be with them, to give them spiritual strength to carry the message of the Gospel throughout the world. Many of His followers were fishermen and had very little education. On the day of Pentecost, they were gathered together in the "upper room" waiting for a sign from heaven. Suddenly there came a great sound from heaven which was like a rushing mighty wind. It filled the house where the disciples were waiting. Great tongues of fire were seen over each of the heads of the Disciples. It was the power of the Holy Spirit which brought divine inspiration to all in the house. They began to speak many languages, and they were "filled with the Holy Spirit". This was the fulfillment of the promise which the Lord had given to them. The disciples traveled to the far corners of the earth to bring the message of Jesus Christ to all men.

During the Divine Liturgy today, all Orthodox Christians take part in the service known as "the service of kneeling". The priest reads three prayers about the miracle of Pentecost, during each prayer the entire congregation kneels and prays also. It is during this time that we pray that the power of the Holy Spirit will enter our hearts also and give us spiritual strength to live out our lives according to the will of God. Let the power of the Holy Spirit enter our hearts and transform us into the way and Will of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Feast of St. Mary for Good Crops & Harvest. DATE: 15 May 2023



In origin this is an agricultural feast which arose from the needs of the farmers to seek God's help for a fruitful harvest. The farmers were at the mercy of the elements and depended upon sufficient rain and good weather. As a result they sought God's assistance and begged the intercession of Mary for their crops. Saint Ephrem speaks of Mary in this regard when he says that Mary became of the field who received the grain of wheat in her womb and this grain of wheat, Jesus Christ our Lord, gives life to the world. Through the harvest we receive the gifts of bread and wine which become for us the body and blood of Christ in the Eucharist.

Ascension of our Lord, DATE: 18 MAY 2023

The Lord Jesus passed forty days on earth after His Resurrection from the dead, appearing continually in various places to His disciples, with whom He also spoke, ate, and drank, thereby further demonstrating His Resurrection. On this Thursday, the fortieth day after Easter (Kyamto), He appeared again in Jerusa-lem. After He had first spoken to the disciples about many things, He gave them His last commandment, that is, that they go forth and proclaim His Name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. But He also commanded them that for the present, they were not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait there together until they receive power from on high, when the Holy Spirit would come upon them. Saying these things, He led them to the Mount of Olives, and raising His hands, He blessed them; and saying again the words of the Father's



blessing, He was parted from them and taken up. Immediately a cloud of light, a proof of His majesty, received Him. Sitting thereon as though on a royal chariot, He was taken up into Heaven, and after a short time was concealed from the sight of the disciples, who remained where they were with their eyes fixed on Him. At this point, two Angels in the form of men in white raiment appeared to them and said, "Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into Heaven? This same Jesus, Who is taken up from you into Heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen Him go into Heaven" (Acts 1:11). These words, in a complete and concise manner, declare what is taught in the Symbol of Faith concerning the Son and Word of God. Therefore, having so fulfilled all His dispensation for us, our Lord Jesus Christ ascended in glory into Heaven, and sat at the right hand of God the Father. As for His sacred disciples, they returned from the Mount of Olives to Jerusalem, rejoicing because Christ had promised to send them the Holy Spirit.

It should be noted that the Mount of Olives is a Sabbath's day journey from Jerusalem, that is, the distance a Jew was permitted to walk on the day of the Sabbath. Ecumenius writes, "A Sabbath day's journey is one mile in length, as Clement says in his fifth Stromatis; it is two thousand cubits, as the Interpretation of the Acts states." They draw this conclusion from the fact that, while they were in the wilderness, the Israelites of old kept within this distance from the Holy Tabernacle, whither they walked on the Sabbath day to worship God.

Pentecost, DATE: 28 MAY 2023




On this day we recall that just 50 days after the Glorious Resurrection and 10 days after the Victorious Ascension of our Lord, the Holy Spirit came upon the Holy Apostles and all those gathered with. (Acts of the Apostles Chapter 2) We celebrate the bringing of the Holy Spirit, Pentecost, the fulfillment of the Resurrection in the heart of man. Christ prophesied it Himself, and the fulfillment we hear in the Acts of the Apostles. Usually, when we have a feast day, the primary reading will be from the Gospel, in terms of the content of the feast, but the event of Pentecost is described in the Acts. 'Acts of the Apostles' is the account of continuation of the history of Salvation and hence it is included in the New Testament giving next importance to the Gospel. The Ascension of our Lord, the dissension of the Holy Spirit and indwelling in the Church, in the heart of each believers and the early history of the Church are

described there. The book is hence also called the 'Work of the Holy Spirit.' The event of Pentecost is the link between Gospel and other part of the New Testament. It shows that the Church is the Church of Triune God; continuation of Creation, redemption in Christ and growing in Spirit.


Apostle St. James

The holy, glorious, all-laudable Apostle James, also knows as James the Great was a son of Zebedee, the brother of the Apostle John and a fisherman. He and his brother John are know as the Sons of Thunder, because of their quick temper. At the invitation of Jesus he left his nets to follow him and is counted among the Twelve Great Apostles. Belonging to Christ's 'inner circle', James was present on Mount Tabor for Christ's transfiguration and also for his suffering in the garden of Gethsemane. Following Pentecost, St. James preached in Spain, and upon his return to Jerusalem the Jews would argue with him vehemently concerning the Holy Scriptures. None could withstand his wisdom, however, seeing this, the Jews slandered him before Herod and among some false witnesses there was a certain Josias. But in hearing St. James' testimony, Josias believed and was condemned to death with James.




Before the axe fell, St. James embraced and kissed this repentant false witness and said, "Peace and forgiveness to you!" St. James was martyred in the year AD 45 and was the first Apostle to die for Christ. His body was translated to Spain where his relics continue to work miracles even to this day.

Apostle St.John



The holy, glorious and all-laudable Apostle and Evangelist John (also John the Theologian or John the Divine) was one of the original twelve Apostles, and wrote the Gospel bearing his name; three canonical letters: I John, il John, and Il John; and the Book of Revelation. His symbol is the eagle. St. John was the son of Salome the myrrh-bearer and Zebedee, a fisherman. His brother was St. James, another apostle. In his own Gospel account, he refers to himself as "the disciple whom Jesus loved" rather than use his name. He was the youngest of the twelve apostles, and especially close to the Lord. This closeness is often portrayed in icons of the mystical supper, where St. John leans on Jesus. He was present for the Transfiguration of Christ with Peter and his brother James. St. John was exiled to the island of Patmos by

Emperor Domitian around 90-95 A.D., and it was there that he received and wrote the Book of Revelation.

മലങ്കരയുടെ പ്രഥമ കാതോലിക്ക ആയ ബസേലിയോസ് പ്രഥമൻ കാതോലിക്ക ബാവ 1836 ജനുവരി 17 ന് പ്രശസ്തവും അതിപുരാത നവുമായ പകലോ മറ്റം കുടുംബത്തിന്റെ, ശാഖയായ മുറി മറ്റം കുടുംബത്തിൽ കുര്യന്റെയും മറിയാമ്മയുടെയും മകനായി ജനിച്ചു. 1852 ൽ 16ാം വയസിൽ വൈദിക സ്ഥാനവും തുടന്ന് 1877 ൽ വയസ്സിൽ മാർ ഈവാനിയോസ് എന്ന മേൽപ്പട്ടസ്ഥാനത്തേക്കും ഉയർത്തപ്പെട്ടു. 1912 സെപ്റ്റംബർ 15 ാം തീയതി നിരണംപള്ളിയിൽ വച്ച് അബ്ലുള്ള മശിഹാ രാണ്ടാമൻ പാത്രിയർക്കീസിനാൽ മലങ്കര സഭയുടെ പ്രഥമ കാതോലിക്ക ബാവ സ്ഥാനത്തേക്ക് തിരഞ്ഞെടുക്കപ്പെട്ടു. ദീർഘദർശിയായിരുന്ന തിരുമേനി ധാരാളം വിദ്യാഭ്യാസ സ്ഥാപനങ്ങൾ സ്ഥാപിക്കുന്നതിലും ക്രമങ്ങൾ ചിടപ്പെടുത്തുന്നതിലും. പള്ളികളിൽ സൺഡേസ്കൂൾ തുടങ്ങുന്നതിനും, മലങ്കര സുവിശേഷ സംഘം സ്ഥാപിക്കുന്നതിനും, സഭാമക്കൾക്കു വേണ്ടി അനേകം പള്ളികൾ സ്ഥാപിക്കുന്നതിനും ആ വന്ദ്യപിതാവിന് സാധിച്ചു. വർണ്ണനകൾക്കതീത മായ പ്രവത്തനങ്ങൾ മലങ്കര സഭയ്ക്കു കാഴ്ചവച്ച ആ മഹാ താപസശ്രേഷ്ഠൻ 1913 മെയ് മാസം 3ാം തീയതി കാലം ചെയ്തു. പാബാക്കുട ചെറിയ പള്ളിയിൽ കബറടക്കം ചെയ്തു.



ബസേലിയോസ് മാർത്തോമ്മാ ദിദിമോസ് പ്രഥമൻ കാതോലിക്ക ബാവ

മലങ്കര ഓർത്തഡോക്സ് സഭയുടെ അഭിമാനമായിരുന്ന ബസേലി യോസ് മാർത്തോമ്മ ദിദിമോസ് പ്രഥമൻ 1921 ഒക്ടോബർ 29ാം തീയതി ഇട്ടിയവിര തോമസിൻെയും ശോശാമ്മയുടെയും മകനായി മാവേലിക്കരയിൽ ജനിച്ചു. 1950 ൽ വൈദിക സ്ഥാനത്തേക്കും തുടർന്ന് 1966ൽ മേൽപ്പട്ട സ്ഥാനത്തേക്കും ഉയർത്തപ്പെട്ടു. തോമസ് മാർതിമോത്തിയോസ് എന്ന നാമധേയത്തിൽ ഭ്യദാസനത്തിന്റെ മെത്രാപ്പോലിത്ത ആയിരുന്ന ഇദ്ദേഹത്തെ 1992 സെപ്റ്റംബർ 10ാം തീയതി കൂടിയ മലങ്കര സൂറിയാനി ക്രിസ്ത്വൻ അസോസിയേഷൻ ബസേലിയേസ് മാർത്തോമ്മ മാത്യുസ് ദ്വീതീയന്റെ ഗാമിയായി നിയുക്ത കാതോലിക്കാസ് സ്ഥാനത്തേക്ക് തിരഞ്ഞടുത്തു. 2005 ഓക്ടോബർ 31ാം തീയതി ബസേലിയോസ് മാർത്തോമ്മ ദ്വീദിമോസ് പ്രഥമൻ എന്ന പേരിൽ പരുമല സെമിനാരി തിൽ വച് പൗരസ്ത്യ കാതോലിക്കോസും മെത്രാപ്പോലിത്തയായി അവരോധിക്കപ്പെട്ടു. വനിതകൾക്കു പൊതു യാഗങ്ങളിൽ സംബന്ധിക്കുവാൻ അനുവാദം നൽകിയതും മെത്രാൻ തിരഞ്ഞെടുപ്പിനു മാനദണ്ഡവും പെരുമാറ്റച്ചട്ടവും ഏർപ്പെടുത്തിയതും ഇദ്ദേഹമാണ്. വാർധക്യ സഹജമായ കാരണങ്ങളാൽ



ഒഴിഞ്ഞ ഇദ്ദേഹം നിയുക്ത കാതേലിക്ക ആയിരുന്ന പൗലോസ് മാർ മിലിത്തിയോസിനെ 2010 നവംബർ 1ാം തീയതി പുതിയ കാതോലിക്ക ആയി വാഴിച്ചു. വലിയ ബാവ എന്ന് സഭ ആദരവോടെ വിളിച്ചിരുന്ന വന്ദ്യപിതാവ് 2014 മെയ് 26 ന് കാലം ചെയ്തു. പത്തനാപുരം മൗണ്ട് താബോർ ദയറായിൽ കബറടക്കം ചെയ്തു.


