GLORY BE TO THE TRIUNE GOD

Dearly Beloved in CHRIST,

“It is good to give thanks to the Lord, and to sing praises to Your name, O Most High. To declare Your lovingkindness in the morning, And Your faithfulness every night” (Psalm 92:1-2).

Firstly, let us begin the second half of the yearly journey by first thanking the Lord our God for all His Choicest Blessings in our lives and with the prayer for His Valuable Guidance and Blessings for our future. There was once a student who used to say ‘thank you’ for everything. The teacher asked him why he had to say a ‘thank you’, when many people don’t consider it helpful. His reply amazed the teacher when he said that he was thanking God for all the people and the help he received. He also added that, many times, we don’t know how well we have been protected and helped by God.

“Do unto others as you would have them do unto you.” (St. Luke 6:31),

Secondly, we should remind ourselves on the above commandment. This Golden Rule is essential in every part of our lives. The Feast of St. Thomas (Dukhrono) (St. Thomas Perunnal 2nd to 9th July 2023) St. Thomas the Apostle of India is the Patron Saint of the Malankara (Indian) Orthodox Syrian Church as well as our Church. St. Thomas was martyred on 21st December and the importance of 3rd July is the translation of his holy relics from Mylapore to Edessa.

St. Thomas, also known as Didymus, was one of the 12 Apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ. Though he initially did not believe other Apostles about the Resurrection of our Lord, our Lord allowed him to touch His wounds and thus St. Thomas declared, “My Lord and my God”, which are the very wordings used by the Holy Church. Our Lord said to St. Thomas, “Because you have seen Me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.” This is a blessing for all who have not yet seen the Lord but believe in Him. Among famous miracles of St. Thomas in India is one in which, when he threw water droplets from a flowing stream into the air, it hung suspended in the form of sparkling flowers. The story of the king Gondophares is prominent and can be found in history. The king learnt, the treasured knowledge, from St. Thomas that when we help the poor and needy on earth, we can obtain riches in heaven. St. Thomas also established the seven and half Churches in Kerala.

In our Church, the flag hoisting will be done on 2nd July, celebrations will continue from Wednesday, 5th July till 9th July, with the Rasa on Saturday evening, 8th July and Holy Munnumel Qurbana on Sunday morning, 9th July. We also celebrate 3rd July as Parish Day.

May the prayers and intercessions of our Patron Saint, St. Thomas the Apostle of India, be with our Church, our families, our children, and with all our beloved ones, both near and far away.

St. Thomas the Apostle

Feast Day: July 3 and December 21

The Apostle Thomas was born in the Galileian city of Pansada and was a fisherman. Hearing the good tidings of Jesus Christ, he left all and followed after him.

According to Holy Scripture, the holy Apostle Thomas did not believe the reports of the other disciples about the Resurrection of Jesus Christ: “Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into His side, I will not believe” (St. John 20:25).

On the eighth day after the Resurrection, the Lord appeared to the Apostle Thomas and showed him His wounds. “My Lord and my God,” the Apostle cried out (St. John 20:28). “Thomas, being once weaker in faith than the other apostles,” says

St John Chrysostom, “toiled through the grace of God more bravely, more zealously and tirelessly than them all, so that he went preaching over nearly all the earth, not fearing to proclaim the Word of God to savage nations.”

According to Church Tradition, the holy Apostle Thomas founded Christian churches in Palestine, Mesopotamia, Parthia, Ethiopia and India. Church Tradition also indicates that Apostle Thomas baptized the Magicians needed. Preaching the Gospel earned him a martyr’s death. For having converted the wife and son of the prefect of the Indian city of Meliapur (Mylapore), the holy apostle was locked up in prison, suffered torture, and finally, pierced with five spears, he departed to the Lord. Part of the relics of the holy Apostle Thomas are in India, in Hungary and on Mt. Athos.

72 Evangelists

Feast Day: July 5

The Seventy Two Evangelists are those whom the Lord chose in addition to the Twelve Apostles and sent forth to assist in the work of preaching. Over time, the Twelve added others to their number, who were sent out with the original Seventy Two to preach the gospel. In Luke 10:1 we read “After his the Lord chose another seventy two men (including Mark and Luke) and sent them out 2 by 2, to go ahead of him to every town and place where he himself was about to go”.



H.H. Baselios Marthoma Paulose II,

The Eighth Catholicos of the East in Malankara (2010–2021)

Feast Day: June 12

His Holiness Baselios Marthoma Paulose II was enthroned as the Catholicos of the East & Malankara Metropolitan (the Supreme Head of the Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church of India) on Monday, 1st November 2010. His Holiness is the 91st Primate on the Apostolic Throne of St. Thomas. Born on 30th August 1946 in a village called Mangad near Kunnankulam, Trissur District, Kerala as the son of the late Kollannur Iype and the late Pulikkottil Kunjeetty, the boy K.I. Paul had his early education in local schools. After graduating from St. Thomas College, Trichur, Paul joined the Orthodox Theological Seminary, Kottayam from where he obtained G.S.T and B.D. degrees of the Serampore University. After taking the holy orders, he joined C.M.S College, Kottayam and took his M.A in Sociology. ▶



At the young age of 36, the church Parliament (Malankara Syrian Christian Association) elected Fr. K.I.Paul as Bishop. On 15th May 1985, he was consecrated as Episcopa (bishop) with the new name Paulose Mar Miliythios. Subsequently, His Grace was elevated as the first Metropolitan of the newly formed Kunnamkulam diocese on 1st August 1985. The Malankara Syrian Christian Association held at Parumala on 12th October 2006 unanimously elected His Grace Paulose Mar Miliythios Metropolitan as the Catholicos Designate and the successor to the Malankara Metropolitan. On 1st November 2010, following the abdication of his predecessor, His Holiness Baselios Marthoma Didymus I. His Grace Paulose Mar Miliythios Metropolitan was enthroned as the Catholicos of the East & Malankara Metropolitan with the new name His Holiness Baselios Marthoma Paulose II. Incidentally, Kunnamkulam which is a stronghold of the Orthodox Community in Kerala has given birth to three Malankara Metropolitans including the reigning Catholicos. His Holiness' illustrious Predecessors Pulikottil Joseph Mar Dionysius II and Pulikottil Joseph

Mar Dionysius V were towering personalities who contributed much to making the Malankara Church what it is today.

It was His Holiness' keen interest that the Church should have effective and meaningful Inter-Church relations. It is with this emphasis that His Holiness has already finished journeying to all the Oriental Orthodox Churches. Once in this short span of time as Catholicos, he has already had meetings with all the present heads of the Oriental Orthodox Churches. The fraternal relations with the sister Churches too have been given prime importance. The meeting with the present Pope of the Catholic Church has enhanced the bilateral relations between the two Churches. His Holiness' unassuming character and his philanthropic interests, have given new dimensions to the life of the Church. He has authored a few devotional and contemplative books in Malayalam. His Holiness had been called to the eternal abode on 12 July 2021. His mortal remains is interred in the Chapel at Catholicate Palace, Devalokam, Kottayam, India.



St. Yulithi & St. Kuriakose

Feast Day: July 15

The blessed Yulithi (Julietta) and her saintly son trampled the devil and all his wicked means under their feet and received the crowns of martyrdom. Yulithi, a beautiful rich woman and a good Christian, a descendent of the Asian kings, was born in Iconium in Asia Minor where St.Paul and Barnabas founded the church. Yulithi spent most of her time in praying and helping the poor. Yulithi's only son Kuriakose (Cyrucus) grew up in a spiritual atmosphere whose first spoken words were "I am a Christian". When Yulithi's husband passed away all on a sudden, she had to raise her son by herself. Dioceltian, the Roman emperor, started the worst Christian persecution when Kuriakose was only three years old.

Yulithi, in order to escape from persecution, fled to Selucia in Syria with two of her maids. As the situation there was also worse, they went to Tarsus, the birthplace of St. Paul. The Roman tetrarch in that city, Alexandros was also very cruel towards Christians. Yulithi was arrested and brought before Alexandros. Because Yulithi confessed that she is a Christian as against all warnings of Alexandros, the soldiers threw Yulithi on the ground after taking away young Kuriakose from her. Alexandros promised to release her if she forsook Jesus Christ to which she answered that even a child, like her son, would not budge. Alexandros asked Kuriakose: "Would you agree to worship the idols". Young Kuriakose replied: "Your idols are made by stone and wood; My real God is Jesus Christ". When Yulithi heard this, she filled with courage shouted: "I am a Christian; I worship the real God Jesus Christ who made heaven and earth". Then Kuriakose also started shouting "I am a Christian; I am a Christian".





Soldiers continued beating Yuliti and the ruler tried to play with the boy to attract his attention. The tetrarch got mad at the child as he was not falling into his trap and threw him to the ground. The young boy hit his head against one of the concrete steps and died instantly. When Yuliti saw this, she prayed: "Thank you my Lord because you considered Kuriakose worthy of receiving this glorious crown. I ask you now my Savior to take me also....." On hearing this, the angered Roman emperor ordered her to be beheaded. Thus she was beheaded while she was repeatedly saying: " I am a Christian, I am a Christian". At night, her two maids took the bodies and hid them in a cave near Tarsus.

When Constantine, the first Roman emperor, came to power, he built a church where the Mother and the child were martyred. Parts of the relics of these two saints' are preserved in the Syrian St.Mary's Monastery in the valley of Nitron. There is also a historical church bearing their name in Tahta.



Prophet Elijah

Feast Day: July 20

Elijah of great fame was from Thisbe or Thesbe, a town of Galaad (Gilead), beyond the Jordan. He was of priestly lineage, a man of a solitary and ascetical character, clothed in a mantle of sheep skin, and girded about his loins with a leathern belt. His name is interpreted as "Yah is my God." His zeal for the glory of God was compared to fire, and his speech for teaching and rebuke was likened unto a burning lamp. From this too he received the name Zealot. Therefore, set aflame with such zeal, he sternly reprov'd the impiety and lawlessness of Ahab and his wife Jezebel. He shut up heaven by means of prayer, and it did not rain for three years and six months. Ravens brought him food for his need when, at God's command, he was hiding by the torrent of Horraath. He multiplied the little flour and oil of the poor widow of Sarephtha. Elijah of great fame was from Thisbe or Thesbe, a town of

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St. Mary Magdalene

Feast Day: July 22

Saint Mary was from Magdala in Galilee on the Sea of Tiberias, and for this was named Magdalene. When the Lord Jesus cast out seven demons from her, from which she had been suffering, she became His faithful and inseparable disciple, following Him and ministering unto Him even to the time of His crucifixion and burial. Then, returning to Jerusalem together with the rest of the Myrrh-bearers, she prepared the fragrant spices for anointing the body of the Lord. And on the Lord’s day they came very early to the tomb, even before the Angels appeared declaring the Resurrection of the Lord. When Mary Magdalene saw the stone taken away from the tomb, she ran and proclaimed it to Peter and John. And returning immediately to the tomb and weeping outside, she was deemed

worthy to be the first of the Myrrh-bearers to behold the Lord arisen from the dead, and when she fell at His feet, she heard Him say, “Touch Me not.” After the Lord’s Ascension, nothing certain is known concerning her. Some accounts say that she went to Rome and later returned to Jerusalem, and from there proceeded to Ephesus, where she ended her life, preaching Christ. Although it is sometimes said that Saint Mary Magdalene was the “sinful woman” of the Gospel, this is nowhere stated in the tradition of the Church, in the sacred hymnology, or in the Holy Gospels themselves, which say only that our Lord cast seven demons out of her, not that she was a fallen woman. “Madeleine” is a form of Magdalene.

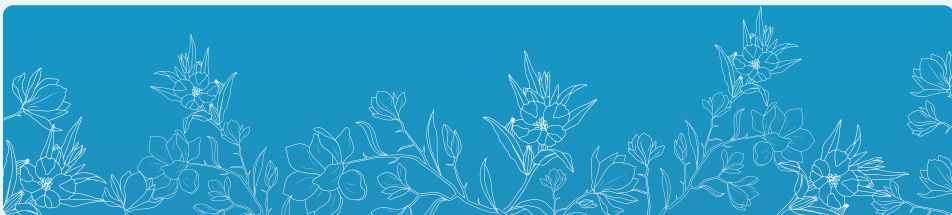
